

## QUEEN OF HEAVEN SCHOOL DRESS CODE 2009 – 2010

If a student does not comply with the uniform policy, the following actions will be taken:

1<sup>st</sup> offense – verbal warning; 2<sup>nd</sup> offense – uniform violation warning will be sent to parents; 3<sup>rd</sup> offense – final uniform violation warning will be sent to parents; 4<sup>th</sup> offense – a detention will be issued. Warnings may be issued for any violation including: shirts not tucked in, no belt, skirts that are too short, or colored shirts/camisoles under uniform shirts.

All students are expected to be well groomed and neatly dressed at all times. Students in grades 1 through 8 are to wear the school uniform each day. Uniform options are listed below:

### Uniform Guidelines for All Students Grades 1 - 8

#### BOYS – Grades 1 - 5:

**Pants** - Solid navy blue dress pants should be worn with a belt. Pants should not be faded. No corduroys or cargo pants may be worn. Pants may be purchased from the uniform company or any local store.

**Shirts** – White dress shirts or golf shirts may be worn with either short or long sleeves. Ties in a solid navy blue should be worn with dress shirts. These are available in the school office. Golf shirts with the school crest are available through the uniform company. **Shirts must be tucked in.**

#### GIRLS - Grades 1 – 5:

The plaid jumper and a long or short sleeve white blouse is basic uniform attire. During the winter months (November – April), navy blue uniform slacks may be worn with a white blouse or golf shirt. **Blouses must be tucked in.** Plain white, navy blue, cream or gray socks or tights may be worn.

#### BOYS – Grades 6 – 8:

Junior high boys may wear either navy blue or khaki slacks with a belt. Pants should not be faded. No corduroys or cargo pants may be worn. **Shirts must be tucked in.** White dress shirts or golf shirts may be worn with either short or long sleeves. Ties in a solid navy blue should be worn with dress shirts. These are available in the school office. Golf shirts with the school crest are available through the uniform company. **Shirts must be tucked in.**

#### GIRLS – Grades 6 – 8:

A solid navy blue, pleated uniform skirt and a long or short sleeve white blouse is basic uniform attire. During the winter months (November – April), navy blue or khaki uniform slacks may be worn with a white blouse or golf shirt. **Blouses must be tucked in.** Plain white, navy blue, cream or gray socks or tights may be worn.

**No makeup may be worn.**

**Sweatshirts/Sweaters** – Queen of Heaven school or team sweatshirts may be worn as well as plain navy blue sweaters which may be purchased through the uniform company. Children in pre-k through grade 2 may not wear hooded sweatshirts in school.

#### Jewelry – Girls

Girls may wear stud earrings only; no hoops or dangling earrings. Earrings should be removed during gym class. Only one earring may be worn in each ear. No other piercings are allowed. Simple cross necklaces and rings are acceptable.

#### Jewelry – Boys

No earrings or piercings of any kind are allowed. Religious medals may be worn but no other necklaces.

#### Walking Shorts

All students may wear school uniform navy blue walking shorts during the summer months (May – October). Belts must be worn with shorts. Shorts are available through the uniform company. **No cargo shorts are allowed.**

#### Shoes

Dress shoes are to be worn each day. **No flip-flops, clogs, sneakers, platform shoes or outdoor boots may be worn due to safety issues.**

**Skirt Length** – Girls

All skirts must be an appropriate length, no shorter than 3” above the knee. Any girl who wears a skirt that does not meet these guidelines will be required to lengthen the skirt by letting down the hem or exchange it for a skirt of appropriate length from our used uniform supply.

**Out of Uniform Days**

On school days designated as “Out of Uniform Days”, rules of good taste and appropriate attire must be observed. The following are not allowed on out of uniform days:

\*Any clothing that is too short, too tight or too revealing.

\*Any tops that are too short or that reveal the midriff

\*Any halter tops or tops with spaghetti straps.

\*Any shorts that are cut too low at the waist or do not conform to the length requirement of reaching the fingertips when holding one’s hand at one’s side.

\*Any item of clothing that has inappropriate words or messages.

If a student arrives at school inappropriately dressed, he or she will be asked to call home for appropriate attire. If other attire cannot be provided, the student will be given clothing from the used school supply for the day.

**Students who choose to disregard uniform policies will be given appropriate uniforms from our supply to wear for the day or trade in permanently.**
